

2024 MASCUSA National Specialty

Breed Observations by Judge Nannette L. Newbury

There is no greater honor for a judge than being selected to judge a breed's National Specialty, and this assignment exemplified that for me as well. As an offshoot of the Australian Shepherd, the Miniature American Shepherd is a breed I feel close to and identify with. I was honored to assist in developing the breed standard and creating the first Judge's Education Seminar for the breed.

To explain my judging process, I follow the advice of the great Anne Rogers Clark, who emphatically stated that judges should "make the first cut on type, and then reward the soundest of the typical specimens." If you select first on soundness, thus ignoring type, you can end up with a dog that in no way correctly resembles or is identifiable as a MAS. Breed type matters. In some classes, I could have awarded a dog with better breed type, a higher placement over a more sound dog. It is not a matter of not understanding movement; it is a matter of understanding breed type.


When I judged Sweepstakes classes at the Nationals in 2018, I remember seeing many atypical breed type exhibits, with overly domey topskulls and bulging round eyes. I also saw many dogs with a "hackney" lift to their front legs. Fast-forward to 2024, and I can say that I saw very few, if any, domey topskulls. The overt lift to the front end from the elbow instead of the shoulder was seen less. These are significant improvements in the breed.

Regarding eye shape...I saw many more correct almond-shaped, non-protruding eyes than in 2018. This is a positive. However, there were some lovely dogs shown with round eyes and round and bulging eyes. Eyesight and eye shape directly affect function and safety but also contribute greatly to breed type. Breeders need to continue to select and promote the correct eye shape and to continue eliminating bulging round eyes going forward.

The majority of dogs had the correct texture and length of coat, and very few were overcoated with excessive coat length. In terms of substance, I saw very few dogs that were "overdone" or had too much bone, which is an issue in the Australian Shepherd today. However, I did see some dogs that lacked substance for their size, especially in the rear legs.

Many dogs were out of coat, which doesn't bother me as a judge, and I understand that coat dramatically enhances the "look" or appearance of substance. However, keeping the correct and moderate substance in the breed should be addressed. Maintaining substance is one of the most challenging traits in any breed. Breeding moderate dogs to moderate dogs will not maintain substance. These dogs will lose substance over time. It is necessary to have dogs that perhaps carry more substance than the breed standard requires in order to maintain substance in a breeding program.

The overall and most unfortunate issue for the breed was the location of the withers on the dogs. Ideally, the withers should be over the elbows. Your standard states, "Viewed from the side, the elbow should be directly under the withers."



I was stunned at the number of dogs whose point of the withers was inches (sometimes many inches) in front of the elbow, well up into the neck. If I had to guess, I would say that at least 90% of the dogs were like this. In addition, the shoulder layback was overly wide, rather than the points of the shoulder blades being close at the highest point. In some cases, the shoulders were overly muscled, making it difficult to feel not only the point of the withers but the width of the withers.

Every one of these dogs had a structurally corresponding restricted front reach. This means the front legs could not reach forward correctly with a smooth, free, and easy gait supporting the breed's function. The dogs were thus not balanced front to rear. The lack of proper location of the shoulder blades restricts the correct length of reach (stride length) of the front legs, while the rear legs often were correct with good drive. Many outstanding exhibits had this fault. Correct fronts are the most difficult to acquire and maintain in any breed. This would be the area where I would offer advice to breeders. After selecting pups for breed type, focus on getting the withers back to the proper location on the neck and topline.

In terms of judging coming and going, it is incumbent on the handler to train the dog to execute a straight down and back. A judge cannot see your dog's correct movement if the dog is not moving at the correct speed in a straight line. For the most part, exhibitors did a great job on their down and backs. Regarding breed soundness, I saw several dogs with overly wide fronts. I am not talking about dogs that lacked convergence but dogs that were grossly wide in the front. Many of the rears converged properly at speed, much better than today's Australian Shepherds, which are dominated by dogs with narrow and parallel rears.

I posted a notice on the whiteboard outside the ring asking exhibitors to move their dogs on a loose lead and at the correct speed for the dog. I commend all exhibitors for executing my wishes. By doing so, I could judge each dog's movement properly, and each dog looked its best. I do not think I had to ask one handler to move the dog "more slowly!"

In terms of my selections, I was incredibly honored by the overall numbers and quality of the breed. I was thrilled with my BOS dog being an 8-year-old veteran and my Select Bitch being a 13-year-old veteran. You should all be very proud of the longevity and quality of the breed.

My Winner's Dog was from the puppy class, and he was a promising exhibit that also won Best Puppy. When I first saw him in his class, I immediately wicketed him as he looked right at the top of the height restriction. He measured in and exhibited excellent breed type and overall quality of smooth, free, and easy movement on the side. My Winner's Bitch exemplified feminine traits, especially in her head, and had a quality of movement to complement her type.

My Best of Breed winner had some good competition from other high-quality bitches in Best of Breed. However, when directly compared to others when moving she held together beautifully and represented correct breed type combined with superior movement. Truly a credit to your breed.

The premium list confined me to selecting five (5) male Awards of Merit and five (5) female Awards of Merit. I would suggest, in the future, allowing the judge to select AOMs based on quality, not sex. In this way, the fancy can receive feedback from the judge on where the quality lies in the breed. It is my opinion that this year the bitches outnumbered the dogs in terms of quality.

Overall, my impression is that the breed has made drastic improvements in a short period, which is incredibly commendable. I would encourage breeders to continue this practice, even as breeding becomes more complex and access to dogs is limited due to government or breeder regulations. While breeder control is understandable, in a breed in such an infancy stage and struggling to preserve quality and set correct type, breeders may wish to reconsider overly restrictive breeding contracts. It is time for the breed to work together for the sake of the future of breed preservation.

Again, it was an honor to be selected to judge at this prestigious event. I am incredibly grateful and hope I exceeded your expectations regarding judging the breed based on the breed standard.
